BILD Alberta supports introduction of Bill 30

EDMONTON – Building Industry and Land Development Alberta Association (BILD Alberta) is pleased to see the Government of Alberta’s introduction of Bill 30 - *An act to Protect the Health and Well-being of Working Albertans*.

“The residential construction industry employs approximately 200,000 workers in Alberta. A comprehensive occupational health and safety system is key to ensuring that homes continue to be built safely throughout the province,” said Carmen Wyton, CEO, BILD Alberta. “BILD Alberta members are committed to ensuring that workers return home safely to their families each day,” said Wyton.

BILD Alberta will be working closely with the Alberta Construction Safety Association (ACSA) to ensure members have the proper resources needed to comply with the Occupational Health and Safety Act, effective June 1, 2018. BILD Alberta will also hold information sessions in the coming months to help prepare members.

“We look forward to furthering our partnership with BILD Alberta. This partnership will ensure that the changes from Bill 30 will be implemented seamlessly for all home builders and land developers in Alberta,” said Dan MacLennan, Executive Director, ACSA.
