Following up on the Member Heads Up from November 23, 2017

<b>Follow Up</b>	<b>On November 23, BILD Alberta sent a <a href="#">Member Heads Up</a> asking for volunteers to review proposed code changes to the 2020 National Codes</b>
<b>Member response</b>	<p>15 members representing single-, multi-family and the plumbing trade responded to assist in the code review.</p> <p>Reviewing the proposed Code changes provided an opportunity to support and supply suggestions that were relevant to Alberta and other jurisdictions before they were adopted into the National Codes.</p>
<b>Outcome</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 124 of the 131 proposed changes were reviewed in depth by the volunteers<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Those that were not reviewed in depth were related to heavy industry or the removal of asbestos references</li></ul></li><li>• No significant changes to current construction or practice were flagged for comment</li><li>• Several minor changes that would enhance clarity were flagged<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Comments were provided to National Research Council and shared with CHBA National</li></ul></li></ul>
<b>Next Steps</b>	BILD Alberta will track the outcome of the suggested changes in partnership with CHBA National and communicate the outcome to members.
