ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The renovation of this entry must have been completed between June 1, 2020 and May 15, 2021 and must not have been entered previously for this category in a BILD Alberta Awards competition.

By entering this project, you confirm that you have read the Eligibility Requirements for the BILD Alberta Awards and that you agree to be bound by the conditions set out for the competition.

Images should be high resolution (300ppi), with an ideal width of 3000px. Maximum image upload size is 5MB. Renderings are not permitted. Do not upload duplicate photos.

PHOTO REQUIREMENTS - Ensuite, Kitchen and Renovator's Choice categories

Before photos (minimum 4, maximum 8)

After photos (minimum 4, maximum 8)

Images should be high resolution (300ppi), with an ideal width of 3000px. Maximum image upload size is 5MB. Renderings are not permitted. Do not upload duplicate photos.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- For the purpose of the BILD Alberta Awards, a renovation is defined as follows: A renovation must include renovator removal of items that are being replaced by the renovator i.e. flooring, countertops, cabinetry, paint.
- Company logo in EPS format
- Residence Name (used in award ceremony)
- Address of Submission
- City of Submission
- Cost of the area renovated or entire renovation for home renovation categories
- *No company names on photos, floor plans or in write ups*
- Maximum of three (3) submissions per category

PRICE REQUIREMENTS

The total cost of the renovation for the category entered. Include: An estimate of the dollar value of any materials the homeowner self-supplied (e.g. kitchen appliances).

- Upload a copy of a line-item breakdown of the renovation cost indicating the full retail value of the renovation.
- Discounts (i.e. Employee or supplier extended promotional pricing) must be added back into the line-item price(s) such that line item price(s) reflect retail customer pricing.
- The retail value of appliances must be included in the line-item breakdown.
- This includes the retail value of customer supplied appliances.

PROJECT INFORMATION & SCORING CRITERIA

a. Overall Appeal, Special Features and Unique Design Elements (45 points)

Describe how the project responds well to the goals of the homeowner and note its unique design elements and special features. **150 word maximum**

b. Creative Use of Space, Functionality and Integration within the Home (35 points)

Describe the floor plan and your approach to making the most effective use of space in order to achieve the successful integration with the rest of the home. **150 word maximum**

c. Addressing Challenges (25 points)

Outline the challenges involved (e.g. solutions to overcome space limitations, construction challenges or bylaw restrictions) and how well those challenges were met in this renovation. **125 word maximum**

d. Value (5 points)

No comments required. Judges will rate the perceived value of the renovation compared to other entries by looking at the finishes, features and reading comments.
