ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The community service must have been completed between May 1, 2023 and May 15, 2024 and must not have been entered previously for this category in a BILD Alberta Awards competition.

By entering, you confirm that you have read the Eligibility Requirements for the BILD Alberta Awards and that you agree to be bound by the conditions set out for the competition.

PHOTO REQUIREMENTS

Minimum four (4) to a maximum of eight (8) colour photos of community service initiative(s).

Images should be high resolution (300ppi), with an ideal width of 3000px. Maximum image upload size is 5MB. Do not upload duplicate photos.

The Community Service Award is presented to a company that has demonstrated qualities of compassion and service to either one organization or a variety of volunteer activities in one year.

The company cannot receive monetary benefit for the charitable activities/events or service listed on the application. Cash or product donations will not be considered for this award.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Company logo in EPS format
- Total number of company participants/volunteers
- Date of contribution(s)
- Benefiting charity/charities
- Size of company (number of employees on payroll)

PROJECT INFORMATION & SCORING CRITERIA

Describe the services/actions that made a lasting or meaningful contribution or impact on a community.
500 words maximum

The Executive Committee will score entries on:

a. Need (10 points)

The extent to which the service or action might be considered above and beyond the call of duty.

b. Impact (20 points):

The degree to which their services/actions have made a lasting or meaningful contribution or impact.

c. Inspiration (20 points):

The extent to which the inspires others to volunteer or contribute.

d. Commitment (20 points)

The demonstration of current and continuing involvement in community service.
